
## WordPress Page Builder

Modern WordPress websites have a built-in tool called “Page Builder.” This allows you to more easily edit your own site content. These instructions have been prepared to help you learn to edit your own website. Most instructions are accompanied with illustrations.



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Log in to your WordPress website. You will enter an area called "Dashboard." Click on "Pages" on the left side of the screen, then find the page you wish to edit. Click "Edit" under the page name.

To add information or pictures to a page, click "Add Row."




You will now have the option of dividing this Page Builder row into different sections or leaving it as one field of information. Make your selection where it says "Set Row Layout." The example shows two equal sized sections. Click insert to add the row.




The sections do not have to be equal in size. You might make 2 sections for pictures at first, then decide later to change it to 3 pictures in a row. You can easily make that change later.


Next you need to add a "Widget." Click on the section you're going to add a widget to, then click on "+Add Widget."




The Widget screen will appear. Click on "SiteOrigin Editor." (Not pictured here) It will be added to your row automatically.




When you move your cursor over the widget, you will see “Edit Duplicate Delete.” Click on “Edit” and the widget will open.



This is where you will type in information or insert pictures. Your website has been set up so that you can choose the size and color of your font. You may align your line of text or paragraph in the center, to the left or right.





When you're finished with this widget, click on "Done" in the bottom right corner.



If you wish to add a picture to this widget rather than adding text, click on "Add Media."

The Media Library will open. Click on "Upload Files" to upload a picture from your computer. Click on "Insert Into Page" which is located in the lower right corner.



Once the picture has been inserted into the widget, click on the picture and a bar will appear. The four icons on the left control the alignment. Clicking on the "x" will delete the picture. To edit the picture's size, click on the pencil icon OR you may grab the corner and pull/push to resize the picture.



If you click on the pencil icon, a window will open (see below) where you will be able to edit the "Display Settings."





To view your website, move your cursor to the upper left corner of the screen and "Visit site" will appear. Click on "Visit site." OR you may click on View page to see only the page you have just updated.



The website 'Log out' is accessed by moving your cursor to the right upper corner of the screen. The option to log out will appear under the "Howdy" greeting.



### Editing a row:

If you decide you want to edit a Page Builder row, such as to change how it's divided, move your cursor to the "wrench" icon over the right side of the row. Options will appear that will enable you to edit the row, duplicate the row, or delete the row. Click on edit to change how that row is divided. In other words, you may change it from being divided into three sections to two or four sections. Click "Update."

### Moving a row:

Use the icon on the right like a "handle" if you wish to move the row to another position on the page. Click "Update."

(Hint: to add a little extra space in an area of your web page, add a row there and leave it blank. Remember to click on "Update.")
